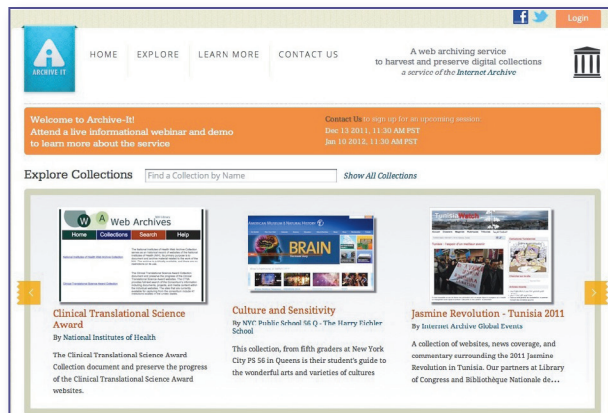

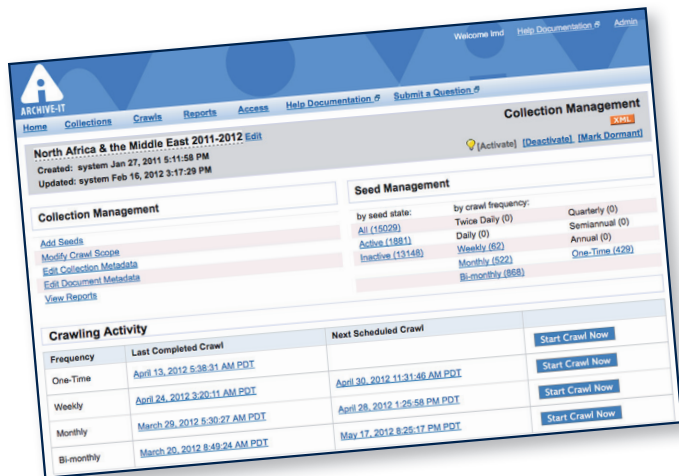


## Archive-It: A Web Archiving Service

## How do organizations use Archive-It?

- Fulfill an organization's mandate to preserve institutional memory and history
- Archive state/local agency publications that aren't being deposited in print form
- Capture websites and link them to existing collections around the same thematic focus
- Archive organizational culture, including online publications and social networking sites
- Create a web archive on a specific subject or event, including social media sites
- Collect government agency websites and an evolving online presence
- Maintain electronic records management system to meet government and university record retention policies

## FEATURES

### Curator Controls:

- Harvests can be set to 10 different capture frequencies
- Tools to expand or limit scope
- Reports and analysis to evaluate your web harvests
- Dublin Core Metadata and customized fields for cataloging collections

### Archived Content:

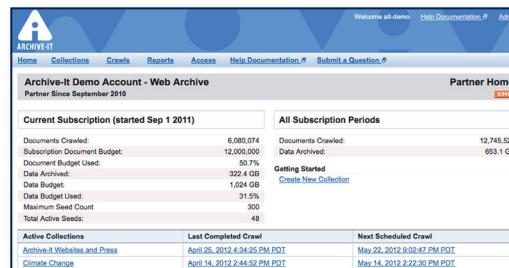
- Includes: html, images, video, audio, PDF, social networking sites, blogs, online newspapers, and much more...

### Access and Storage:

- Collections are browseable by URL and indexed for full text search
- Hosting, access and customized landing pages included
